



Arts events attended in past year




There are changes in *where* people are attending arts events


Online activities in past year





Reasons for <u>not</u> attending live performances/events (top mentions) Subsample: Have not attended a live arts performance in past year (n=263)




Attended or live streamed performances created/performed by... Subsample: Attended or live streamed at least one performance in past 12 months




Is the public connected to the physical space?

Extent to which facilities contribute to quality of life in community


